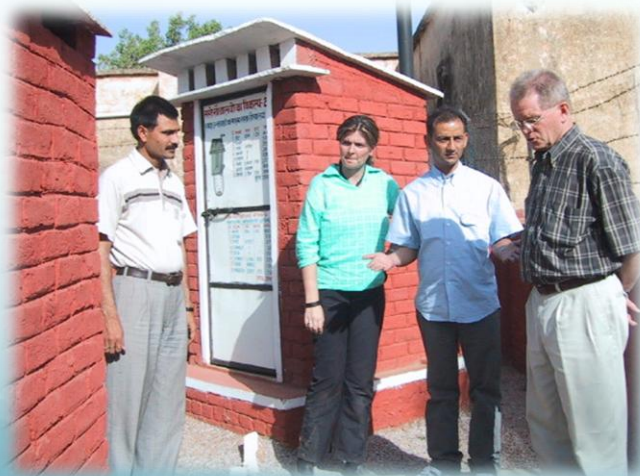


From 2000 – 2004

- 84 villages in Behror, Alwar District, Rajasthan
- Partners: UNICEF and - Gov. Rajasthan (PHED)
- Sanitation Park established at Panchayat Samiti, Behror
- Production Centre established in Behror for mass production of toilet slabs and other products for Water & Sanitation
- 3000 toilets constructed
- 81 Water & Sanitation committees mobilized and trained to maintain the water supply systems.
- Rural Sanitary Marts

The project created demand for good sanitation. Most new houses are now constructed with toilet within the residential area

Production Centre

To facilitate streamlined production of toilet slabs and other products for water and sanitation the project arranged a contract with a local entrepreneur to set up a production centre beside the Sanitation Park

Green Post Tsunami Action - Environmental protection, Water & Sanitation, Food Security



From Dec. 2006 – Feb 2009

- 60 villages in four coastal districts of Tamil Nadu
- Partners: EU, Eco Venture and Practica Foundation, NABARD, Peer Water Exchange

Water & Sanitation related activities:

- Drilling of 60 boreholes & installation of low tech. rope pumps to secure clean drinking water.
- Crafts men at local workshops trained to fabricate rope pumps
- Water committees formed and trained to maintain the pumps.
- 224 Eco-San Toilets constructed
- Training of local masons in eco-san

Community Development Project - Panipat



Oct. 2007 to March. 2014

- Partner:
 - Indian Oil Corporation Limited (Panipat Refinery)
- 560 toilets have been constructed, with 30% contribution from the owners
- Hygiene and health awareness makes part of the process of sanitation promotion.
- Most of the families are constructing a bathroom in addition to the toilet
- All toilets are used and kept neat and clean by the users.

Community Development Project - Rewari



From Oct 2008 to Jan 2011

- 52 villages in Rewari Distr, Haryana
- Partner: United Nations Democracy Fund – UNDEF
- 400 toilets constructed for the BPL families with support from DRDA and contribution from the families.
- A few common toilets were also constructed –
- The single family toilets were a better option

Community Development Project - Ghaziabad



From 2009 - 2010

Partners: Wherever the Need & Stockholm Environment Institute

- 34 Eco-San toilets constructed at residences
- 1 Eco-San toilet constructed in school.
- Good compost can be collected from the dry chamber every 6 months

School Sanitation Project – Uttar Pradesh



From 2008 - 2009

Partner: UNICEF

- Sanitation Awareness Programme in 100 schools in the districts of Agra, Moradabad, Ghaziabad and Lallitpur
- School sanitation committees were formed in all schools
- Many actions such as “Hand Washing Day” and campaigns for cleanliness helped to engage the children and teachers
