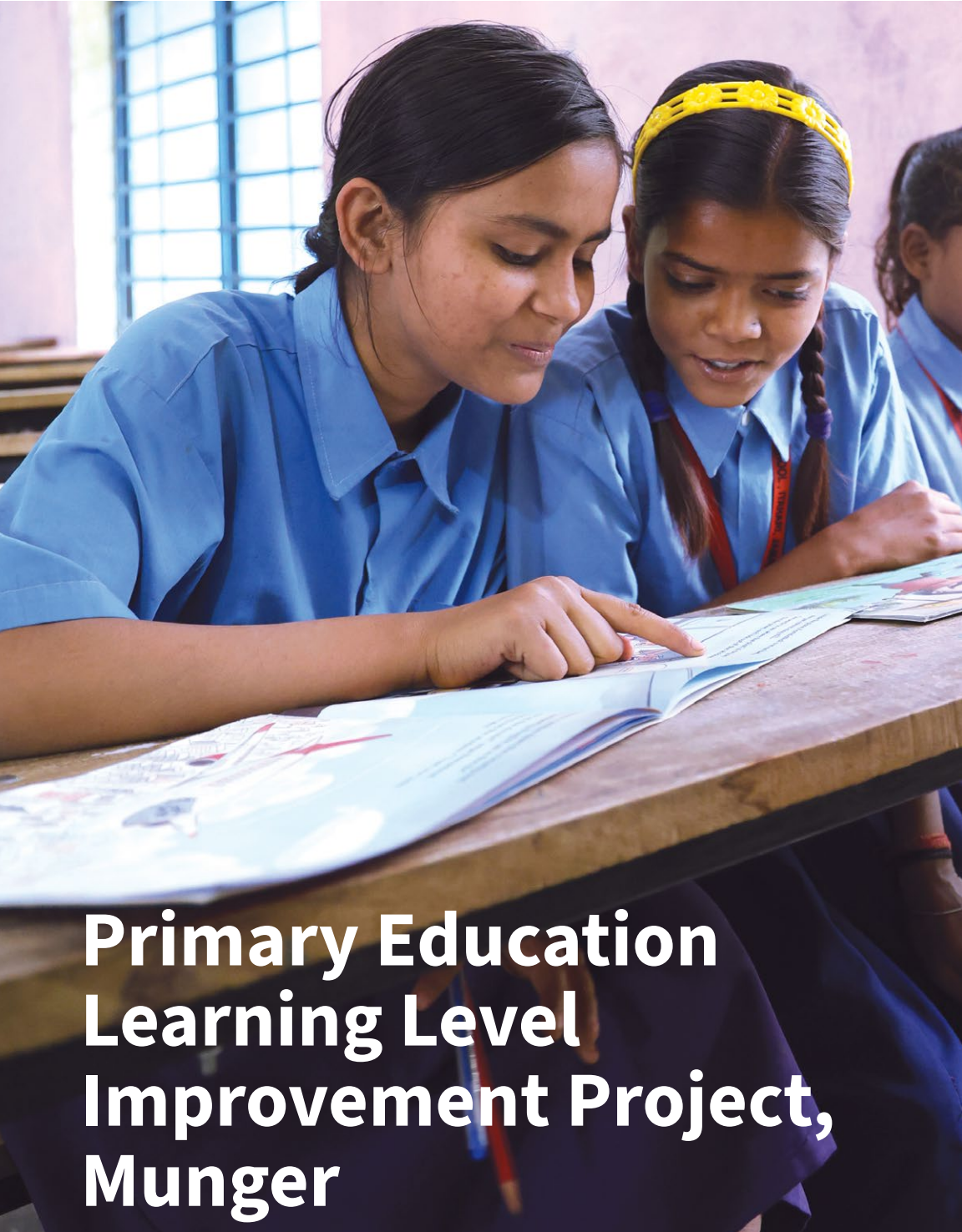

# Primary Education Learning Level Improvement Project, Munger

Primary Education Learning Level Improvement Project, Munger is dedicated to ensuring that every child in Munger, Bihar, receives quality education at an appropriate learning level through innovative pedagogy, community engagement and digital learning interventions. The Project is shaping the future of thousands of children from Classes 1 to 5.

## Project's Reach

**Location:** Sadar Munger and Jamalpur blocks in Munger, Bihar

**Schools Covered:** 263 Government Primary Schools

**Time frame:** 31<sup>st</sup> September 2023-31<sup>st</sup> March 2025



## Project Rationale

The low learning level percentage of students in Bihar highlight the urgent need to strengthen foundational literacy in the early years of schooling. To bridge learning gaps, Humana People to People India partnered with ITC Mission Sunehra Kal, focusing on students in Classes 1 to 5 in Munger who struggle due to limited access to quality resources and structured learning environments.

## Project Interventions

The Project operates with 263 schools to improve the overall development of students. This Project aims to enhance learning outcomes for approximately 27,700 children by improving school infrastructure, providing effective teacher support, introducing digital learning tools and using innovative pedagogy.



The Project ensures grade-appropriate learning through several key initiatives:

### Learning Activity

The Project collaborates with government schools to enhance the capacity of primary school teachers through various training sessions and prepare Teaching Learning Materials (TLMs). Students also work on workbooks to further enhance their learning experience.

### Theme-based Activity

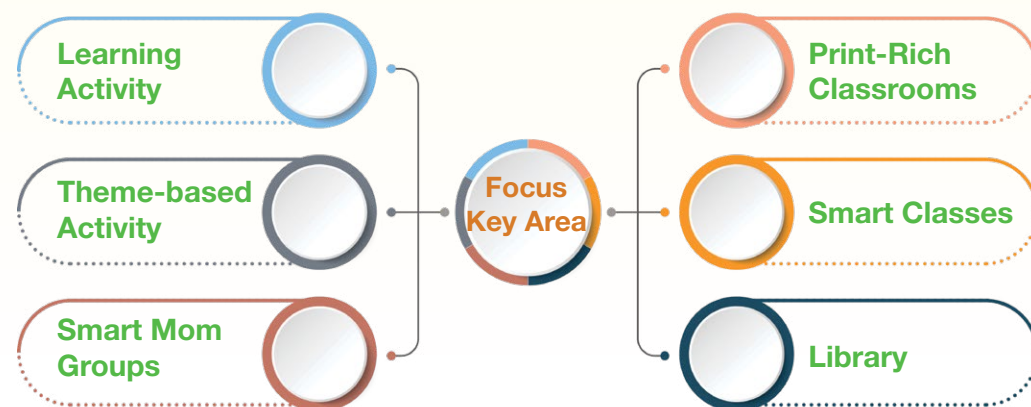
The interventions' emphasis is on comprehensive education through activity-based and peer learning with a focus on developing important life skills in students.

**Smart Mom Groups** provide after-school support to help students meet their learning goals.

**Print-Rich Classrooms** aim at improving learning experiences by making educational content more accessible and engaging.

**Smart classes** are also being utilised to boost student engagement, understanding, and overall academic performance.

**Libraries** have been established to support academic growth and knowledge acquisition among students.

**23,235** children enrolled across various intervention models



**4,662** students completed Class 5th and exited the programme



**18,573** students remain actively engaged in structured learning
