Introduction

The **Model Village Development Project (MVDP)** is a collaborative initiative between Aramco Asia India Private Limited and Humana People to People India, implemented in Sundroj, Rewari District of Haryana. The initiative aims to demonstrate how integrated, sustainable solutions can strengthen rural communities and improve everyday life together with the people in Sundroj village.

Through solar powered drinking water system, solar irrigation pumps, solar streetlights, and climate-resilient farming practices, the project promotes access to clean water, renewable energy, and sustainable livelihoods. Community participation lies at the heart of the initiative, with village action committee, farmer clubs and training programs encouraging local leadership and collective action.

Through the images curated in this book, readers are invited on a visual journey through Sundroj, capturing moments of community action, innovation, and transformation. Each photograph reflects how collective effort, sustainable solutions, and local participation can shape a village into a **model of resilient and inclusive rural development**.

Clean Water for the Community

Access to safe drinking water is fundamental to health. The introduction of **solar-powered RO systems and water ATMs** is designed to provide reliable and affordable drinking water to the community while reducing dependence on conventional energy sources.



Project Inauguration and Handover: An inauguration ceremony was organised on 8th April 2026 in Sundroj village to mark the successful implementation and operationalisation of key interventions under the Model Village Development Programme, supported by Aramco Asia India Private Limited. The event witnessed the presence of senior representatives from Aramco, including the Managing Director, along with leadership from Humana People to People India, project staff, Village Action Committee (VAC) members.

Solar Energy for Sustainable Living

Solar-powered streetlights illuminate the lanes of Sundroj, while solar irrigation pumps enhance support for farmers in their fields. These renewable energy solutions not only improve daily life but also demonstrate how rural communities can embrace **clean and sustainable energy**.



Sustainable and Climate-Resilient Agriculture

Through farmer training, soil testing, vermicomposting units, and innovative technologies such as **AI-based pest detection**, farmers are adopting climate-resilient practices that improve soil health, increase productivity, and support long-term food security.



Strengthening Community Participation

Development becomes sustainable when communities take ownership of change. **Village Action Committees and Farmer Clubs** bring people together to discuss challenges, share knowledge and collectively plan solutions.



Nutrition, Environment, and Green Practices

Kitchen gardens, tree plantation, and biogas units encourage environmentally friendly and sustainable practices while improving household nutrition and reducing reliance on conventional fuels.
